The first Honor Wreaths for Veterans ceremony in Anna was conducted last Saturday morning. The ceremony was at the Anna Cemetery. Many people turned out on a cold and drizzly December morning to pay tribute to the nation's veterans.

Anna's first Honor Wreaths for Veterans ceremony was conducted Saturday morning, Dec. 14.

The ceremony was held at the Anna Cemetery. Even on a cold and drizzly December morning, many people were in attendance.

Saturday morning's ceremony was one of many conducted across the nation in commemoration of National Wreaths Across America Day. Honor Wreaths for Veterans was part of the nationwide tribute.

The theme for the observance was to:

Remember the fallen. Honor those who serve. about the value of freedom.

Organizers noted that in 2018, nearly 1.8 million wreaths honoring veterans were placed on headstones at 1,640 participating cemeteries throughout the country.

The idea for conducting a local ceremony was led by Anna City Council member Martha Ann Webb. Webb writes the Anna News column for The Gazette-Democrat.

More than 300 wreaths were acquired for Anna's first ceremony.

Fellowship House, Centerstone to align services

In a move that will increase the access for substance use disorder services across Southern Illinois, Centerstone and The Fellowship House on Thursday, Dec. 12, announced that they will be aligning their services through an affiliation which is effective in January 2020.

"We are excited by this move because together, we can improve access to life-saving care across the communities we serve. Our affiliation means a stronger continuum of care for a large, underserved area in Illinois," Centerstone regional CEO John Markley said in a news release.

"Each organization has a strong 50-year history of service, and through this affiliation, we plan to reduce barriers to care, enhance the continuum of services and improve opportunities for staff growth, both personal

and professional."

The Fellowship House is a private, not-for-profit, 501(c)(3) charitable organization based in Anna.

The organization provides services to those experiencing substance use disorders and co-occurring problems, and also serves Union County and Massac County schools with a prevention program.

"At The Fellowship House, we know that each person must take things one day at a time. Providing the tools and skills to live a healthier, happier lifestyle has always been our focus, and I'm excited that we will be able to expand upon this through our affiliation with Centerstone" said Mickey Finch, CEO of The Fellowship House for more than 40 years.

"The Fellowship House detox and residential rehab services will enhance Centerstone and, together with Centerstone's services, will

enhance the continuum of for those served by The Felservices and provide even more efficient, timely excellent services to patients."

Finch said she sees the move as the best way to ensure the best future possible

lowship House's programs. The new alignment further is seen as a way for The Fellowship House to grow and thrive.

The Fellowship House

has 25 employees. The Fellowship House serves about 20 to 25 people in its residential detox program. Out-patient care is provided to about 30 to 40 people.

As The Fellowship House and Centerstone join together, Finch said that after 40 years of service, she is planning to retire in early January 2020. After joining The Fellowship House as a counselor in 1979, she became executive director in 1980.

Finch said she will continue to serve as a consultant for six months.

In the first phase of the affiliation plan, the two entities will begin to do business as one, under the Centerstone name.

Members of The Fellowship House board of directors will be invited to ioin the Centerstone board of directors.

Those involved with the new alignment said that current Fellowship House clients and staff should not notice any gaps in their care or employment.

In the second phase, which is slated to begin on will officially be transitioned into Centerstone.

Centerstone is a not-forprofit health care organization dedicated to delivering care that changes people's lives.

Centerstone provides mental health and substance abuse treatment, education and support to communities in Florida, Georgia, Illinois, Indiana, Kentucky and Ten-

Jury finds Carterville man guilty on drug-related charges

Union County State's Attorney Daniel Klingemann reports that Aaron Lee Isaacson, 37, of Carterville, was found guilty on two drugrelated charges on Dec. 10.

Isaacson was found guilty by a Union County jury on one count of unlawful possession of methamphetamine, which is a Class 3 felony, and one count of unlawful possession of drug paraphernalia, which is a Class A misdemeanor.

Isaacson was arrested in March 2018 by Union County Sheriff's Office deputies and Illinois Department of Natural Resources Conservation Police Officers following a traffic crash report in which he was found to be in possession of methamphetamine and drug parapher-

The Class 3 felony carries a maximum penalty of five years in prison.

The case was prosecuted by Union County Assistant State's Attorney Lisa C. Casper.

A sentencing hearing has been set for 9 a.m. on Jan. 30 at the Union County Courthouse in Jonesboro. Isaacson remains in custody at the Jackson County Jail in Murphysboro.

County board meets

Commissioners reorganize, hear praise for work done by sheriff's office, learn about grant, approve appropriations ordinance

Reorganization, praise for work done by the sheriff's office, approval of a budget and appropriations ordinance and news about grant funding were topics of discussion at last week's regular meeting of the Union County Board of Commissioners.

The meeting was Friday morning, Dec. 13, at the Union County Courthouse in Jonesboro.

The first order of business at Friday morning's meeting was the annual reorganization of the county board.

Max Miller was reelected as the board's chairman. Bobby Toler Jr. was reelected as vice chairman of the five-member board of commissioners.

In other business at the meeting:

Shawnee School District No. 84 superintendent Shelly Clover-Hill attended the meeting.

Clover-Hill said she wanted to voice appreciation for the continued work that Union County Sheriff Scott Harvel and the Union County Sheriff's Office do for the Shawnee School District

the department." The commissioners approved a combined annual budget and appropriations ordinance for the fiscal year which began on Dec. 1. The fiscal year continues through Nov. 30, 2020.

Appropriations for the fiscal year total \$36,235,845. The budget will be balanced.

Board of commissioners chairman Miller voiced appreciation to the county's elected officials and department heads for all of the work they did to help ensure that the county has a balanced budget.

Union County Clerk Lance Meisenheimer reported that his office has been awarded a \$30,766.24 grant from the Illinois State Board of Elections.

The Help America Vote Act grant will help to support cyber security for local election authorities.

The commissioners approved two tourism grants: one for \$6,700 to the Shawnee Hills Wine Trail and one for \$2,200 to the Shawnee Hills Wine Trail Lodg-

Chester man sentenced to 30 years in prison for first degree murder

A Chester man has been Union County on Sept. 16, sentenced to 30 years in the Illinois Department of Corrections for first degree murder.

Special prosecutor Matt Goetten and Union County Sheriff Scott Harvel on Monday, Dec. 16, announced the sentencing of William P. Wasmund, 49, of Chester, on one count of first degree murder, which is a Class M felony.

Wasmund also will serve three years of mandatory supervised release.

guilty in September after a four-day jury trial.

Wasmund was arrested in February by Union County Sheriff's Office deputies following an investigation into the death of Jeffery A. Spicer, 54, of Murphysboro.

Spicer was found dead along the highway at 7625 State Route 3 North in rural

Evidence presented at trial showed that Wasmund set a shotgun with a trigger which was set to fire when the door of a shed opened, knowing that such act created a strong probability of death or great bodily harm to any person opening the door of the shed.

The shed was located at the 7625 State Route 3 North property.

Association president calls for respect for reporters on job

National Newspaper Association, NNA, president Matthew Adelman this week issued a call for civility and respect for journalists as they do their jobs.

His call follows the release of a news report about a reporter in Chattooga County (Georgia) who was attacked while covering a local meeting.

Adelman is the publisher of the Douglas (Wyoming) Budget. The Gazette-Democrat is a member of the

Reporter Casie Bryant, who is with an internet publication called All of Georgia, was the victim of battery when the wife of a county commissioner, who was apparently upset at the publication's news coverage, poured a soda over Bryant's head while she covered the meeting. Police were called.

The Summerville (Georgia) News reported that the attacker, Abby Winters, later said she tripped and accidentally poured a dark soft drink over the reporter's head.

But the Summerville police report quoted witnesses hearing Winters say, "she deserved it." Adelman said the in-

cident was a sobering reminder that journalists at all levels of news coverage can draw violent responses to their stories, even at an event as routine as the county budget meeting that Bryant was covering.

"We are seeing a rise in attacks," Adelman said. "National news may focus upon atrocities committed on journalists in other countries and let us think that our tradition of free press protects community iournalists.

"We must be concerned when our domestic tensions wind up focusing on reporters who are simply doing their jobs.

"NNA is calling upon journalists to maintain their professional detachment as they stick to the facts and leave their opinions to the editorial pages, and upon public servants to remember that it is our job to cover their work."




Snow on the streets Tuesday morning



Secondly, this time of year is characterized by a spirit of receiving. We all like to receive gifts, for it proves others love us and are thinking of us.





Ice melters can cause harm to trees

Homeowners should be careful when using ice melters close to trees this winter, said a University of Missouri Extension forester.

"Nearly all ice melters are salts," said Hank Stelzer. They work by lowering the freezing point of water to well below 32 degrees.

This can make sidewalks and driveways safer, but these same chemicals may poison trees if care is not used.

Once the salt crystals have done their job, the resulting saltwater solution can splash onto trees or enter from runoff into the trees' roots, he said.

Both can lead to stunted, deformed growth and leave the tree vulnerable to insects and disease.

Over time, the salts can accumulate in the soil to the point where they can kill trees.

To protect trees close to sidewalks and driveways, choose alternatives such as sand, cinders and biodegradable de-icers, Stelzer said.

Harvest running behind schedule

Record spring rainfall led to late planting; below-average crop anticipated in Illinois

SPRINGFIELD - As the month of December arrived, many Illinois farmers were still working to harvest their corn and soybeans, the state's two largest field crops, and agriculture officials are anticipating one of the smallest harvests in recent years.

As of Nov. 24, only about 88 percent of corn acres in Illinois had been harvested, according to the U.S. Department of Agriculture, down from 100 percent at the same time last year.

Soybean harvesting was 95 percent complete, down from 99 percent a year ago.

That delay is the result of historic rainfall in the spring that drenched many

Broadband infrastructure funds announced

The U.S. Department of Agriculture, USDA, recently announced the investment of \$12.8 million in high-speed broadband infrastructure that will create or improve e-Connectivity for more than 1,650 homes in rural Illinois.

The funding for Illinois was announced as part of the first round of USDA's ReConnect Pilot Program investments.

Wabash Telephone Cooperative Inc. will use a \$12.8 million 50 percent loan-grant combination to deploy 298 miles of fiber-optic cable in unserved areas of Jefferson and Wayne counties in Illinois.

The investment is anticipated to reach 1,684 households, 31 farms, 29 businesses, nine educational facilities, two critical community facilities and one health care center.

parts of the state, preventing ers for the loss of income or farmers from getting seeds into the ground in some cases until as late as June.

Officials at the Illinois Department of Agriculture say the final, official numbers for the 2019 growing season won't be known until early January.

But Rodney Weinzierl, executive director of the Illinois Corn Growers Association, said all indicators point to a below-average

"Our acres of corn this year was the lowest we've had probably since the late 1980s," Weinzierl said in a phone interview.

"Just because of that corn that was prevented from being planted, just because of such wet conditions."

Weinzierl said Illinois farmers planted about 1.1 million fewer acres of corn this year, compared to a normal year, and there was also a big drop-off in soybean acres.

"So it's just something that we've not experienced before," he said.

In addition to fewer acres planted, the U.S. Department of Agriculture is projecting that each acre will produce less this year than in the recent past: about 179 bushels per acre this year, down from 210 bushels in 2018, which was a record for Illinois.

Last year, Illinois harvested roughly 11 million acres of corn, according to USDA estimates.

Those acres yielded about 2.7 billion bushels which, at an average price of \$3.62 per bushel, generated \$8.2 billion in farm income.

Soybean farmers harvested 10.5 million acres, producing nearly 667 million bushels. At \$8.74 per bushel, that generated about \$6.3 billion in income.

Most farmers who left acres unplanted this year had insurance coverage, but those policies only cover farmers for their input costs such as the seeds and fertilizers that went unused.

They do not cover farm-

the cost of land for farmers who lease acreage from other landowners.

"So farmers that rent ground would still have an overall loss," Weinzierl said.

"But it's like any other insurance, it's meant to kind of allow you to be able to

farm again next year."

A spokeswoman for the Illinois Department of Agriculture said final numbers for the 2019 growing season are due to be released Jan. 10.

A separate report will be released in February detailing the state's first year of legal hemp production.

It appears in the Atlantic, a publication around since the 1850s. It is a nationally distributed print magazine with additional online articles.

Even though there were hundreds of sundown towns in Illinois, the author chose Anna to visit. This article puts Anna in the national spotlight, not in a positive way. Much of that is because of the way some people still repeat how the letters of the town's name stand for a very ugly history.

I had many similar experiences as described in the article, of people I barely knew explaining to me what the letters stand for. When working in education I had students volunteer to explain to me what the letters stand for.

What happens next is up to the people of Anna and Union County. They can ignore the article or they can use it as a spark for change. The change needs to start with city and county leaders making a public statement which acknowledges the history and pledging to make whatever changes are necessary to make sure we are not repeating the mistakes of the past.

Next, it would be very beneficial if the public schools throughout Union County could develop a curriculum that helps young people know this is not something to be proud of. It would be a perfect opening for an entire unit that reveals the history of segregation north of the Mason-Dixon line and the rough road we have been on since Reconstruction.

Churches should also be a great place to start a discussion about our history and how we move forward. Lastly, it's important that we let other people know it is not funny or appreciated when they continue to repeat this sad acronym

Illinois state fire marshal stresses safety when decorating, celebrating this holiday season

The holidays are here and that means many people will be decorating their homes. Hanging up decorations is fun, but keep in mind, holiday decorations can increase your risk for a home fire.

According to the National Fire Protection Association, more than two of every five home decoration fires occur due to decorations being placed too close to a heat source. More than one-third of home decoration fires are started by candles.

"More than half of home decoration fires in December are started by candles," says Illinois State Fire Marshal Matt Perez. "The top three days for home candle fires are Christmas Day, New Year's Day and New Year's Eve. Before you head to bed or out for the evening, blow out all lit candles. Turn off all light strings and decorations before leaving home or going to bed."

Here are some tips to keep in mind to stay fire safe when decking the halls this holiday season.

Be careful with holiday decorations. Make sure decorations are either flame retardant or flame resistant.

Keep lit candles at least 12 inches away from decorations or anything that can catch fire.

Keep children and pets away from lit candles.

Check to make sure your lights are rated for indoor or outdoor use or both.

Replace any light strands that have worn or broken cords. Make sure to read the recommendation for number of light strings you can string together.

If you have a real Christmas tree, make sure to check water levels daily. It is not unusual for a tree to drink two gallons of water the first day it is in the stand.

Keep real Christmas trees away from a heat source. It can dry out the tree quickly.

After a busy cooking day, before firing the oven back up to prepare the next holiday meal, make sure to clean it. In case of an oven fire, turn off the oven and keep the door closed until it is cool. Clean cook tops, since left-over grease can catch fire. Thanksgiving is the peak day for home cooking fires, but Christmas and Christmas Eve follow closely behind.

If you are planning to host family and friends during the holidays, make sure they are aware of your fire escape plan. Show them where all the exits are in your home and make sure they are aware of the meeting spot's location.
